Dürer was commissioned to paint an altarpiece for the chapel dedicated to All Saints, which was to show the adoration of the Holy Trinity by the communion of the saints with all Christians. The Trinity is in the centre of the picture: God the Father is enthroned on the clouds and holds the crucified Christ. Above it hovers the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove. Today is the Solemnity of all Saints. The Church celebrates the memory of the countless holy men and women from different origins and nationalities (cf. Rev. 7:9), heroes and heroines of Christian faith and witnesses of Christian charity through their lives. Saint Augustine shares us three simple reasons why we do celebrate their memory: first, for inspiration from their examples; second, for participation in their merits and lastly, for the intercession of our prayers.
