In this gentle image we see the angel appearing to Saint Joseph. Joseph is depicted in semi-darkness, his body curled up asleep at his desk in his carpenter's workshop. The angel is gently pointing towards the cribs in the crib in the next room, foretelling what is about to happen. Joseph's slumped pose with heavy draped clothes echoes the weight of his responsibility: protector of the Son of God. The stillness of the night is tangible. **Blessings, Mother Cherry**
